Q: How did you come up with your clown name?

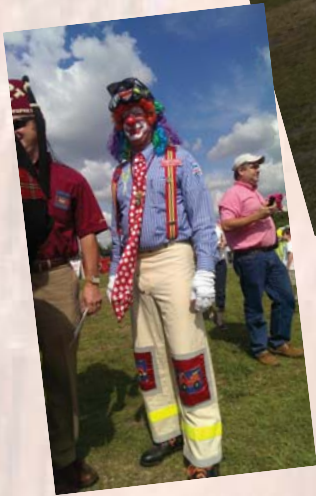
A: While watching The Big Bang Theory on TV one night my wife said, "your clown name could be Bazinga!" and so it was.

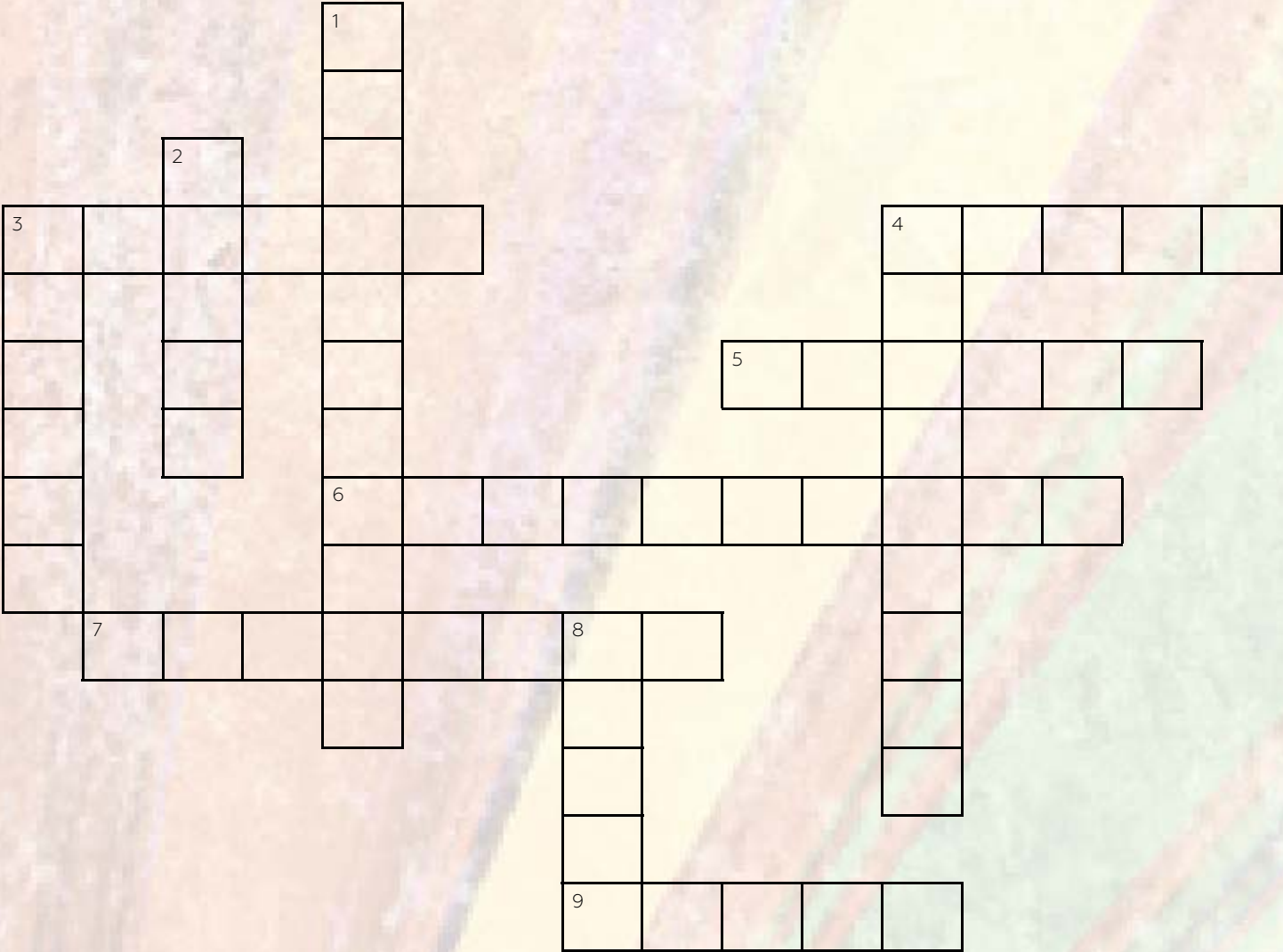

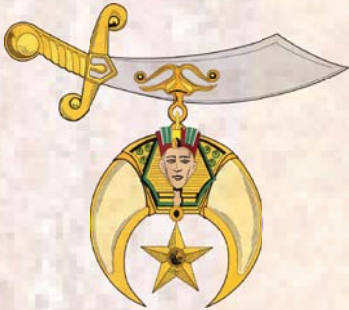
