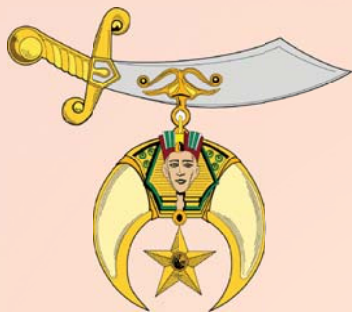
Thoughts for the week

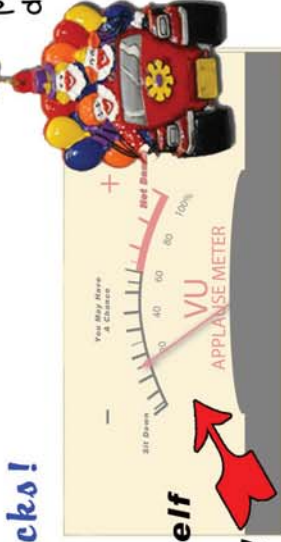
